Task	Observation	Ideas
<u>(1) Find Software</u>	<u>User comfortable navigating</u> <u>Internet to get to Tor website</u>	
<u>(2) Download</u>	<u>Download button was clear</u> <u>and easy to find on website</u>	
<u>(3) Start Tor Browser</u>	<u>Slightly confused about words</u> <u>like proxy, bridge</u>	<u>User different language</u> <u>(or don't use bridge at all,</u> <u>just describe the scenario</u> <u>where I would need to</u> <u>use a bridge – e.g. if I live</u> <u>in an environment where</u> <u>tor is blocked, etc.)</u>
	<u>User hesitated because of this</u>	
<u>(4) Tor Network Settings</u> <u>(Setup)</u>	<u>Chose the first option without</u> <u>understanding what it meant</u> <u>(connect directly to Tor network;</u> <u>did not use proxy because they</u> <u>didn't understand)</u>	
<u>(5) Open Tor Browser</u>	<u>It opened shortly; she was</u> <u>happy with the success!</u>	
<u>(6) Verify Tor is Working</u>	<u>Went back to settings to try to</u> <u>understand the IP address on</u> <u>"check tor" page (couldn't find</u> <u>information about location right</u> <u>away and therefore wasn't sure</u> <u>if it was working</u>	
	<u>Quite frustrated with landing</u> <u>page because of language and no</u> <u>confirmation of location</u>	<u>Would like to see that</u> <u>her location did indeed</u> <u>change; easy to put</u> <u>location on the landing</u> <u>page alongside IP address</u> <u>so they don't have to go</u> <u>look it up on their own.</u>
	<u>Unhappy, had to go to a</u> <u>separate website to tell her the</u> <u>IP address location; only</u> <u>numbers on landing page (3m)</u>	
<u>(7) Access Content</u> <u>(blocked safely)</u>	<u>Successfully accessed</u>	<u>check.torproject.org</u>
